The Game

What you need to know before starting.

House-banked poker is played with five cards and you win by drawing a hand that beats the house.

The number of players must be the same as the number of marked betting boxes, and the maximum is seven per game.



Before the cards are dealt, each player must place an initial bet in the box marked “1ª” (first). Once these wagers are placed, the dealer announces “no more bets.”

Progressive Jackpot

Players may choose to make an additional bet for the progressive JACKPOT, placing €1 in the slot in front of their box to win a cumulative prize from the tables within the Casino set up for this purpose.

A player receives 10 percent of the JACKPOT for a **STRAIGHT FLUSH** and 100 percent for a **ROYAL FLUSH**.

The Game Starts.

After the initial bets are placed, the dealer distributes the cards face down one by one, with the last card for the house dealt face up. **To beat the house your hand must be better than the dealer's.** If it is not a better hand, you lose. In case of a tie, you neither lose nor win your bet.

The players look at their cards without removing their arms from the table and then make one of the following choices:

- To continue by saying “play,” doubling the bet and placing their cards in the box marked “2^a” (second).
- To withdraw by saying “fold,” forfeiting their initial bet. The dealer then picks up the cards.

At this point, the dealer turns the bank's cards up. The dealer only qualifies if it has a minimum of both an Ace and a King, or a higher combination.

- If the house does not have both an Ace and King, or better, it must pay each player the amount of the initial bet to stay in the game.
- If the house plays, the dealer compares its cards to those of the players, pays the better hands and collects all lost bets.

If players exchange information about the cards they are holding the game is voided and all bets are forfeited to the house.

The Game

Additional Wagers.

Buy an additional card.

Players may discard one card and buy another for the value of the initial bet. When it is their turn, they do this by putting down the card they don't want along with an amount equalling the initial bet.



Winning hands and payouts.

- **ROYAL FLUSH 100-1**

The five highest cards of the same suit, which are always the 10, Jack, Queen, King and Ace.



- **STRAIGHT FLUSH 25-1**

Five cards of the same suit in a continuous sequence.



- **FOUR OF A KIND 20-1**

Four of cards of the same value, and one different.



- **FULL HOUSE 7-1**

Three of a kind and a pair.



- **FLUSH 5-1**

Five cards of the same suit not in a continuous sequence.



- **STRAIGHT 4-1**

Five cards of different suits in a continuous sequence..



- **THREE OF A KIND 3-1**

Three cards with the same value, and two more of different rank.



- **TWO PAIR 2-1**

Two pairs of cards with different values.



- **ONE PAIR 1-1**

Two cards with the same value



- **MINIMUM HAND ACE-KING**

In the event of a tie = highest card
